RESOLUTION NUMBER 3166

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS IN ITS EFFORTS TO CONTROL ITS POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE CIVIL WAR BY PASSAGE OF PROPOSITION A ON NOVEMBER 6, 2012, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, passage of Proposition A is critical to the future viability of St. Louis; and

WHEREAS, one-third of the St. Louis city budget is spent on the Police Department and yet the city's elected officials have no control over that spending; and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2012, the passage of proposed Proposition A would increase the efficiency, accountability, and effectiveness of the St. Louis Police Department, reduce state and local costs, and save state and local taxpayers millions of dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Fulton, urges all citizens of the State of Missouri to join him in protecting the rights of the St. Louis Police Officers by restoring local control where it belongs - with the city and the people of St. Louis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FULTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Mayor LeRoy D. Benton and members of the City Council of the City of Fulton, Missouri, on behalf of our citizens, do hereby acknowledge and support Proposition A on November 6, 2012.

SECTION TWO: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
